Local Authority Data

As part of our assessment and tracking system in our Nursery, we will share individual children's information with the Local Authority.

This information consists of name, date of birth, gender, NHS number and a summary of their development in all 17 aspects of learning.

The Local Authority will use this data for analysis and to support raising attainment in our nursery.

This data will not be shared with any outside agencies.

Change of Clothes

Nursery can be a messy affair and, although we do have aprons and waterproof clothing, children will still get dirty and wet from time to time. We want your children to enjoy exploring paint, glue and other messy materials, as well as wet weather.

Please can you make sure that your child has a spare set of clothes on their peg when attending Nursery.

Hints and Tips - please send your child in easy and manageable clothing. This will encourage your child to be independent - laces can be awfully hard when you're only 2,3 and 4! Also please name ALL clothing, including gloves, scarves, hats, etc.
