## ADMISSION CRITERIA

Currently the criteria for 2-year-olds in England to get free early education and Childcare is the following:

- All two years old who are looked after by the Local Authority (LA)
- Children who have a current statement of special educational needs (SEN) or an education, health and care plan
- Children who are eligible for Disability Living Allowance
- Children who have left care through special guardianship, child arrangements order or through an adoption order

## FAMILIES IN RECEIPT OF BENEFITS

Two year olds whose parent/carers are in receipt of one of the following:

Income Support, Income based job seeker's allowance (JSA), Income related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit, Child Tax Credit and have an annual income not over £16,190, Working Tax Credit and have annual gross earnings of no more than £16,190 per year, Universal Credit and the household net earned annual income is equivalent to and not more than £15,400, assessed on up to three of the parent's most recent Universal Credit assessment periods.

If your child is eligible, you can start claiming free early education after your child turns 2. The date you can apply will depend on when their birthday is as proof of eligibility only lasts for two months from the day of application.

## WORKING PARENTS

If you are working more than 16 hours per week at national minimum wage, and earn less than £100,000 net income per year, you may be eligible for 15 hours childcare for your 2 year old.
